Academic Credits

According to the Standards for Establishment of Universities in Japan, one credit requires 45 hours of study including contact hours, self-study, and assignments.

At Aichi Prefectural University, one class session of 90 minutes is converted to two contact hours.

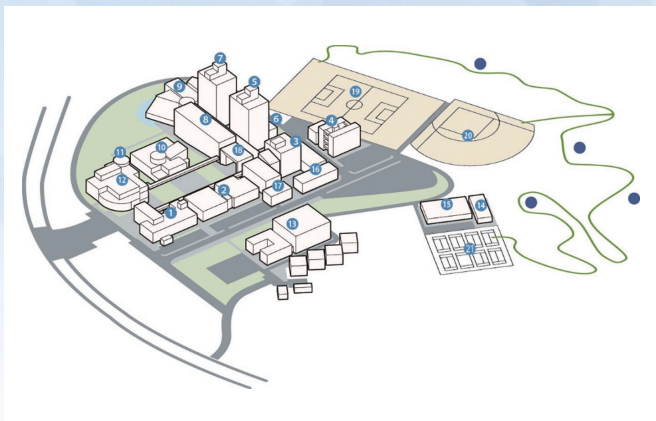
